

CONSENT AND RELEASE FOR KIDS-N-KEYS SAFE DRIVING PROGRAM

I, _____, the undersigned, in my individual capacity and/or in my capacity as legal guardian of the person(s) designated as "PARTICIPANT" below, (collectively, the "PARTICIPANT") acknowledge that PARTICIPANT has agreed to participate as a student or observer (if a parent or legal guardian accompanying a student under 18 years of age) in the Kids-n-Keys Safe Driving Program (the "Program") of Honda of America Mfg., Inc. ("Honda") to be held at the Transportation Research Center (the "Center"). I have paid the established fee for the student PARTICIPANT to Transportation Research Center, Inc. ("TRC"), which Honda has retained to conduct the Program. In consideration of the student PARTICIPANT'S enrollment in the Program and, in acknowledgment that PARTICIPANT'S participation and/or observation of the Program involves potential dangers and risks to persons and property alike, I specifically agree to the following:

- I voluntarily assume all risks and hazards which may cause injury, damage or loss to the PARTICIPANT or to his/her property or any property in his/her possession, while such person or property is in, on or en route to or from Honda's property, including the Center.
- 2. I hereby specifically release, indemnify, and hold harmless Honda, TRC, any affiliates of Honda and TRC, and their respective stockholders, officers, directors, employees, representatives and agents, including the Program instructors, from any claims, losses, liabilities, demands, damages or costs (including attorneys 'fees) of any kind resulting from any injury, medical condition or complication, or damage or loss of any kind to the PARTICIPANT or to his/her property or any property in his/her possession, whether caused by the acts or omissions of Honda, TRC or any of the persons mentioned in this Consent and Release, or the acts or omissions of any other PARTICPANTS, Center staff, other third parties or otherwise.
- 3. Although I recognize that no duty to do so exists or is hereby created, nevertheless in the event the PARTICIPANT sustains any personal injury or medical condition or complication either before, during or after the Program at the Center, I specifically authorize Honda, TRC, and/or their respective representatives to do either or both of the following, should they so choose:
- a. Voluntarily and gratuitously perform on-site treatment for the injury, condition or complication, and/or voluntarily and gratuitously provide transportation for the purpose of obtaining treatment elsewhere. I expressly recognize that any on-site treatment will not necessarily be performed by persons having medical training, including training as emergency medical technicians, and I acknowledge that neither Honda nor TRC has in any way represented that this treatment will be performed by persons having such training. I further understand that neither Honda, TRC, nor their respective representatives who perform any on-site treatment and/or provide any transportation for the purpose of obtaining treatment elsewhere will expect or accept any remuneration for the same. Therefore, and in return for this voluntary and gratuitous treatment and/or transportation, I, on behalf of the person designated as PARTICIPANT, hereby specifically release, indemnifty, and hold harmless Honda, TRC, any affiliates of Honda and TRC, and their respective stockholders, officers, directors, employees, representatives and agents, including the Program instructors, from any claims, losses, liabilities, demands, damages or costs (including attomeys fees) of any kind resulting from such treatment and/or transportation, whether caused by the acts or omissions of the persons performing the treatment and/or providing the transportation, or otherwise;
- b. Make arrangements with third parties for medical treatment for the injury, condition or complication, including but not limited to emergency, laboratory, diagnostic and/or surgical treatment, and/or to make arrangements with third parties for transportation for the purpose of obtaining such treatment. I expressly give my consent for this treatment and/or transportation to any emergency medical services, physicians, nurses, other medical personnel, hospitals and/or medical transportation services that Honda and/or TRC may select, and I specifically agree that I will assume full responsibility for payment for such treatment and/or transportation.
- I agree that Honda may utilize certain demographic information about the PARTICIPANT for its own internal reporting and analysis.
- In the event of any PARTICIPANT misconduct, TRC reserves the right to remove PARTICIPANT from TRC premises.

FINALLY, I ACKNOWLEDGE THAT I HAVE CAREFULLY READ AND FULLY UNDERSTAND ALL OF THE PROVISIONS SET FORTH IN THIS CONSENT AND RELEASE, AND THAT I HAVE FREELY AND VOLUNTARILY CHOSEN TO AGREE TO THE SAME. This Consent and Release shall be binding upon the heirs, administrators, executors and assigns of the person signing below.

A SAFE DRIVING PROGRAM DEVELOPED BY







The Kids-n-Keys program was designed to improve youth and adult driving by applying advanced driving techniques in a safe, controlled, hands-on environment. The program is conducted through Transportation Research Center Inc. (TRC), a 4,500-acre automotive proving ground, where students receive advanced training with experienced instructors and special, innovative equipment. The program is available to spouses, children and grandchildren of Honda (HNA, HRA, HAM, HTM and EGA) and TRC Inc. associates.

Driver's education has been shown to reduce teen crash rates and lower the number of traffic tickets received.




WHAT TO EXPECT

Students will learn advanced driving skills in a hands-on environment, including skid control, braking, turning and backing techniques. The four-hour course allows students to practice defensive driving in a controlled environment. An instructor is always present in the vehicle, and there is a 3:1 student to instructor ratio. Highlighted teachings include:

- Differences in road surfaces and how it affects a vehicle's performance; and
- Differences in braking systems at speeds up to 50 miles per hour

The program is offered twice each Saturday. The cost of the course is \$100, and students must have a valid driver's license in order to participate.

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Classroom Training

(approximately 20 minutes)

Students will discuss and become familiar with proper driving techniques and the dynamics of vehicles.

Hands-on Training

(approximately 3.5 hours)

SkidCar

The SkidCar is one of the most effective driver training tools available. It teaches advanced driving skills by simulating defensive driving conditions in a controlled environment. Students will have the opportunity to learn how to correct front and rear slides while behind the wheel.

Braking

Students will be taught braking techniques for ABS (antilock braking system) and non-ABS equipped cars.

Backing

Proper mirror adjustment, identification of the blind spot and other important techniques for safe backing will be taught.

Braking and Turning

Students will learn how to brake and turn an ABS equipped car.

Distracted Driving

With infotainment features prevalent in modern automobiles, students will be faced with multiple distractions while driving. Students will learn the importance of eliminating unnecessary distractions while driving.

When a student is not driving, he/she will be a passenger in the training vehicle. The student will continue his/her learning experience by:

- Experiencing and understanding the dynamics of the G forces a passenger would endure in an emergency.
- Hearing the instructor's comments and suggestions to other drivers.
- Asking questions.

Wrap-Up

(approximately 10 minutes)

Participants will discuss the day's events with the instructor and review key points about the techniques learned.
